2009 Royal Melbourne Wine Show

The Royal Melbourne Wine Show is one of Australia's largest and most prestigious wine shows and the annual awards are recognised by the wine producers as an important competition in which to benchmark their produce. As a testament to this, more than 490 Australian wineries have sent in their offering of whites and reds amounting to more than 3,845 entries. The RMWS continues to lead the Australian wine show system in many areas including the introduction of split judging panels in 2005; its associate judging program; top international judges; the use of Riedel Overture glasses in judging; a comprehensive auditing program; and on-going collaboration with the Wine Show Committee of the Australian Society of Viticulture and Oenology to enhance the Show judging system in Australia.

The Royal Melbourne Wine Show was first conducted by the Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria in 1884. It featured 13 entries and has since grown to accommodate over 4600 entries. Incorporating the renowned Jimmy Watson Trophy (first awarded in 1962), the Royal Melbourne Wine Show is recognized both within the industry and by the general public as one of Australia's most prestigious wine shows. It brings together the very best Australian wine makers and producers and is renowned as a benchmark of excellence in wine production.
